WHEREAS the Municipality of Port Hope, the Municipality of Clarington, and the Government of Canada are parties to the Legal Agreement for the cleanup and the long-term safe management of low level radioactive waste;

AND WHEREAS Council at a closed meeting held on October 20, 2020 considered a Staff Report regarding Canadian Nuclear Laboratories request on behalf of Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd. (AECL) for an amendment to the Legal Agreement to allow for the transfer of a limited portion of waste from the Port Granby to Port Hope long term waste management facility;

AND WHEREAS the Legal Agreement requires consensus of the parties to support an amendment to the Legal Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council of the Municipality of Port Hope agrees to the request of AECL regarding an amendment to the Legal Agreement to allow for the transfer of a limited portion of waste from the Port Granby Project to the Port Hope Long Term Waste Management;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Municipality of Port Hope hereby requests the support of the Municipality of Clarington regarding the amendment to the Legal Agreement to allow for the transfer of a limited portion of waste from the Port Granby Project to the Port Hope Long Term Waste Management Facility.
