# TRIBUNAL CITES INFRACTIONS

- NOT FOUND IN STAFF RECOMMENDED ZONING BY LAW
- NOT DEFINED –SEASONAL, SPECIAL, ACCESSORY
- NOTHING TO REGULATE THE FREQUENCY AND TIMING
- NOT SUFFICIENTLY RESPECTFUL OF PROVINCIAL AND REGIONAL POLICY
- DID NOT CONFORM TO THE GROWTH PLAN AND GREENBELT PLAN

- 3. DID NOT CONFORM TO THE GROWTH PLAN AND GREENBELT PLAN
