We are one of the 200+ property owners in Special Study Area 2, and have some concerns about our property being considered for Greenbelt Expansion. We would like council to listen to the concerns of the residents of this area prior to any recommendation to expand the Greenbelt here.

As farmers in the study area, we have seen many changes in the past few years - Holt Road bridge construction making a full cloverleaf at the 401, doubling the traffic, the construction of the 418 feeder road to the 407 and all the new over and under passes on local roads in the area, OPG's proposed expansion are just a few projects that contribute a concerning danger for our farm machinery road travel. This area is certainly not what it was and continues to change. Traffic volumes continue to increase in the area which make it difficult and dangerous for farming here.
